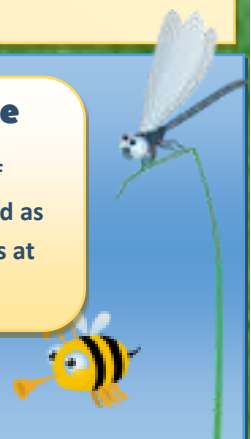
Congratulations to all children as we have received a letter from the Botanical Gardens to say how well behaved our pupils were. Well done.
