NH\$ information re \$carlet Fever/\$trep A — What to look out for

Please look out for the signs of scarlet fever over the Christmas holidays and get in touch with your doctor if your child has the following symptoms:

The first signs can be flu like symptoms, including a high temperature, a sore throat and swollen neck glands (a large lump on the side of the neck).

A rash appears 12 to 48 hours later which looks like small, raised lumps and starts on the chest and tummy, then spreads. The rash makes the skin feel rough like sandpaper.

A white coating also appears on the tongue. This peels, leaving the tongue red, swollen and covered in little bumps (called strawberry tongue). The rash does not appear on the face, but the cheeks can look red.

This is very infectious but can be treated with antibiotics.
