Help and Advice that may be useful to parents

I have received information on Nitrous Oxide use, which although may not be an issue for our parents now, it maybe useful to know for the future.

Nitrous oxide is an odourless and colourless gas inhaled from balloons, or – far more dangerously – directly from canisters, for its psychoactive effects. Symptoms can include feeling relaxed, giggly, sound distortions and/or dizzy, anxious and paranoid. Nitrous oxide inactivates vitamin B12 leading to nerve damage. It can also cause headaches and stop people from thinking straight.
