Parents' Evenings' - Please make an appointment with your child's class teacher to discuss their progress in school. Prior to your appointment you will be able to view their work. Attendance — We would be grateful if you could encourage your children to be in school and arrive on time so as not to disrupt lessons. We realise there are a number of bugs and infections around and appreciate you letting us know when your child is going to be off school so that we can record the absence appropriately.

If no reason is given for absence, or it is a holiday it will be marked as unauthorised. Any unauthorised absences are tracked by the DFE and Staffordshire County Council, which is where any fines are initiated.

Breakfast Club

One of the items in the Government manifesto was to introduce breakfast club for all children. This will be rolled out in September and will be a free service the school will offer.



Landau Forte Greenacres has been selected by the DFE to trial the free breakfast club, for families of primary aged children, from April 2025. It is planned that breakfast club will run from 8.25am until 8.55am every school day. Breakfast will be served until 8.45am.
